Peer-Reviewed and Publication Policy

The editorial board of 'Journal of Applied Research in Humanities, Language and Social Sciences' decides which of the Research papers are to be submitted to the journal for the purpose of publication and the same sent for peer-review process. This policy aim is to ensure that quality based research papers from various subjects to be published. JARHLSS is a biannual multidisciplinary journal. Its review policy, objective is to publish good scholarly papers so that high standard practice of research writing is maintained. All submissions undergo through a review process. Contents of manuscripts with outside the scope will not be reviewed. At least 2 experts will review the papers. If required then editors can also review the papers.

The peer reviewers aim is check the manuscript thoroughly and if required they will suggest revisions. Further, they can reject the paper if they find that paper is not research-oriented. If the paper is rejected for the publication then the same information is notified to authors promptly through mail. Identities of Peer reviewers are kept secret and confidential. The Journal is an open access. Readers can easily read and download full papers freely. All manuscripts submitted will be checked for plagiarism while using Plagiarism Detection Software. Authors should read submission guidelines carefully before submitting their papers.

Same manuscript submitted by the author to different journals will not be accepted at all. It depends upon editorial board to decide about the time of publication. Editorial board can reject or recommend the manuscript for publication. After acceptance, it takes 2 months to publish the papers after following whole procedure. After acceptance of the paper, through mail it is asked to the author to submit their Copyrights of the paper to the Journal. Authors have to mention that their work has not been published before and that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere.
